


REAAA Business Forum

To always encourage, facilitating and connecting Business-to-Business collaboration in road engineering related industry especially in Asia and Australasia regions.


Vision to Be Shared

In the regard, the local organization need to have a strong communication with the REAAA Business Forum Coordinator.










